



Your CMRP Roadmap

The CMRP is a globally recognized credential for the health care supply chain profession. Successful completion of the exam signifies broad-based expertise in the discipline and becoming certified is a great way to advance your career. In addition to providing a comprehensive standard of requisite knowledge, the CMRP designation helps employers, members of health care professions, and the public assess materials and resource professionals as leaders in the field.

Following the steps as outlined below will assist you in earning the certification.



Step 1

Meet Eligibility Requirements

Do you have one of the required combinations of professional experience and formal education?

- 3 years experience in health care supply chain management | Bachelor's degree **OR**
- 5 years experience in health care supply chain management | Associate's degree **OR**
- 7 years experience in health care supply chain management | H.S. degree or equivalent
