The Leadership Award is presented by AHRMM in memory of George R. Gossett, an early President of the Association. Gossett envisioned the prominence of supply chain management in the health care field and championed the educational and professional development of the health care supply chain discipline. The Leadership Award is the highest honor bestowed by the Association.

The Association bestows the Leadership Award to an individual who has demonstrated an extraordinary level of leadership and professional competence in the field of health care supply chain, has made significant contributions to AHRMM, or has advanced the state-of-the-art in health care supply chain management.

The Selection Process

Nominations are reviewed by the AHRMM Advisory Board. The following general criteria are considered in the selection process.

- Leadership role in enhancing the practice and role of supply chain in health care.
- Specific contribution and noted advances in the state-of-the-art.
- Professional contribution and support of AHRMM and the advancement of health care supply chain management.
- Work that has brought special attention and visibility to the profession.
- Personal and professional qualities.

Presentation

The award will be given to the recipient at the AHRMM Annual Conference. The recipient will be recognized in a special presentation and will receive a token of appreciation for his/her involvement and contribution to the health care field. The Association bears the expenses of travel and lodging for the award recipient at AHRMM's Annual Conference.

Nomination Instructions

All nominations for the AHRMM Leadership Award must be completed according to the following guidelines before the application will be accepted. The nominee should be an innovator, distinguished leader, prominent educator or persevering advocate of the profession.

- 1. Complete the Leadership Award application.
- 2. Submit a current resume of the nominee.
- 3. Submit a brief statement, not to exceed three typewritten pages, including the nominee's qualifications or achievements that have occurred within the past five years in each of the following areas:
 - A. Leadership role in health care supply chain related activities.
 - B. Specific contributions that resulted in major advances in the field, in areas such as: technical methods, organization and staffing procedures, advocacy, education, regulatory development, or other areas in health care supply chain management.
 - C. Significant contributions to the advancement and visibility of AHRMM and to the promotion of the health care supply chain profession.
 - D. Personal and professional attributes including integrity, leadership, creativity, strong professional ethics and dedication, as well as a commitment to humanitarian principles.
- 4. Submit a bibliography of articles written by the nominee; list of seminars where nominee has served as faculty; books and speeches published by nominee; and any other documentation that supports the nominee. This material should reflect the nominee's activities within the past five years.
- 5. Please send all nomination materials to ahrmm@aha.org.
- 6. The AHRMM Advisory Board may ask for references to supplement the supporting documentation for the nominee.
