



Your CMRP Roadmap

The CMRP is a globally recognized credential for the health care supply chain profession. Successful completion of the exam signifies broad-based expertise in the discipline, and becoming certified is a great way to advance your career. In addition to providing a comprehensive standard of requisite knowledge, the CMRP designation helps employers, members of health care organizations, and the public assess materials and resource professionals as leaders in the field.

Meet Eligibility Requirements

Do you have one of the required combinations of professional experience and formal education?

- **NEW:** Successful completion of all 5 AHRMM Academy Cohorts **OR**
- **3** years experience in health care supply chain management | Bachelor's degree **OR**
- **5** years experience in health care supply chain management | Associate's degree **OR**
- **7** years experience in health care supply chain management | H.S. degree or equivalent

Take the CMRP Exam

Eligible candidates must apply to take the exam with the American Hospital Association Certification Center. Candidates can schedule their exam with PSI at an approved [testing center](#) or they can schedule a [live-remote proctored](#) exam with PSI.

- You will earn the credential by successfully passing the exam.
- About 4 - 6 weeks after the test, you will receive a certificate of recognition, pin, and information about renewal requirements. Make sure to keep your contact information updated and on file to make renewal an easy process.
